The Tutoring Session

1st Reading

- Sound Practice (Ask, “What sound is this?” Correct mistakes with MOY. Check for mastery.)
- New Sounds (Teach using MOY. Check for mastery)
- Word Practice (Ask, “What word is this?” Correct mistakes with MOY. Check for mastery.)
- New Words (Teach using MOY. Check for mastery.)
- 1st Story Reading (Ask comprehension questions.)
- **Complete the Student Datasheet**

ISP

- Ask, “Who was in the story?” and “What happened in the beginning, middle and end of the story?”
- Dictation (Choose one word from Word Practice and ask the student to write the word.)
- Game (Memory, Word Sort, Make-a-Word, Go Fish, Picture-Word Identification, Fill in the Blanks, Tic-Tac-Toe)

2nd Story Reading

- 2nd Story Reading (Do not ask comprehension questions. Student points to the words.)
- If student makes 2 or fewer mistakes on the 2nd reading, go on to Supporting Activities.
- **Complete the Student Datasheet**

Supporting Activities

- Looking Back (not in every book)
 - Student reads to you. Correct mistakes with MOY. Do not let them practice. **Record data on Looking Back Datasheet.** Call over Teacher or Lead Tutor for student to read it a second time. Follow instructions for next step.
- Coming Attractions (Ask: “What sound/word is this?” Correct mistakes with MOY.)

At the End of the Tutoring Session:

- Give stamps
- **Complete the Student Datasheet**

Mastery of Story

YES = student read the book 2 times with 2 or fewer mistakes on the 2nd Story Reading

N/A = student has not yet read the story 2 times

REDO = student read the story twice with 3 or more mistakes on the 2nd Story Reading

Set Completion Test

Before you move on to a new color of books you MUST call over your Teacher for the Set Completion Test!
